

Question of the Week

(from Deacon Gary Brooks)

Here are questions to discuss at home, based on this Sunday's readings:

For adults: Paul's 2nd letter to the Corinthians ends with the actions of God as Trinity; that we are to receive His grace, live in His peace and share in His love with all we come into contact. What do you do to share with others?

For children: With whom do you share God's love?

The question of the week will come from the scripture passages we read each Sunday during our Mass. The questions are designed for you to share with others in your life about what Jesus means for you and how He interacts with you in your life. You can share them with your family around your dinner table, you can share them before you start a prayer group session or bible study session.

BAPTISM

PREP CLASS-Our next baptism preparation class is Saturday, July 1, at 9:00 a.m. **You must call to register for this class.** Please call after June 20. If there is no answer, dial 21 for Vickie's ext. and leave a message.

To Schedule a Baptism-In order to baptize at St. Elizabeth's, the parents of the child should be registered members of St. Elizabeth's, or live within our boundaries. Parents please come to the office to schedule your child's baptism. You will need to bring in the baby's birth certificate, **from the county**, the godparents' confirmation certificates, if the godparents are married, a copy of their church marriage certificate and proof of baptism prep classes for parents and godparents.

We do baptisms the 1^{ST} and 2^{ND} weekends of each month. The first person to come into the office with all necessary paperwork to register for a weekend will get to pick which day, Saturday or Sunday, for all baptisms that weekend. You must register in the office, before the date of your child's baptism and you must have all paperwork!
